Want to work in law enforcement at UCF? UCF Police Department launches marketing campaign to hire new officers over the next several years.

In a move to increase patrols around campus, the University of Central Florida's police department will hire 15 new officers this year, officials announced Thursday.

The hiring wave is expected to continue over the next several years at the UCF Police Department, which currently employs 68 sworn officers.

University spokesperson Courtney Gilmartin said the officers' base salaries are expected to be \$40,000 a year.

In 2014, the police office dealt with about 1,140 complaints which ranged from criminal mischief to sexual battery to driving under the influence, according to the department's log.

On Monday, the department plans to unveil a marketing campaign to attract job candidates by showcasing a UCF-themed police car and posting the jobs online here.
